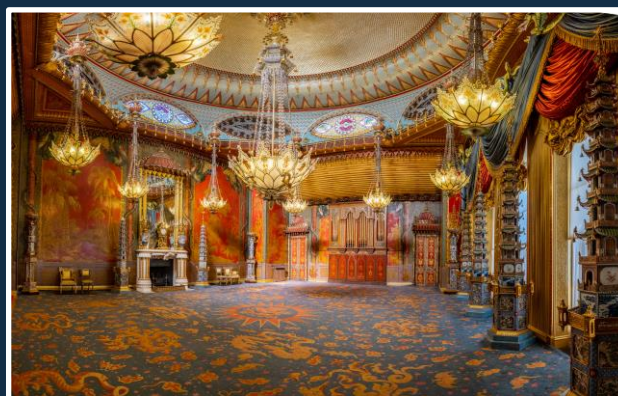
Brighton & Hove Museums offers a collection of cultural, spectacular and diverse venues for hire across Brighton.

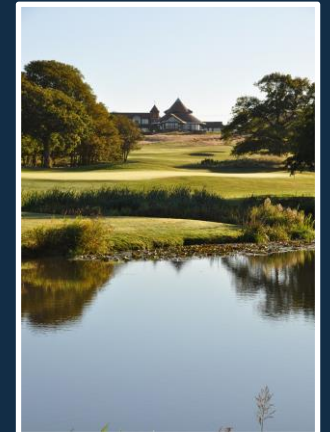

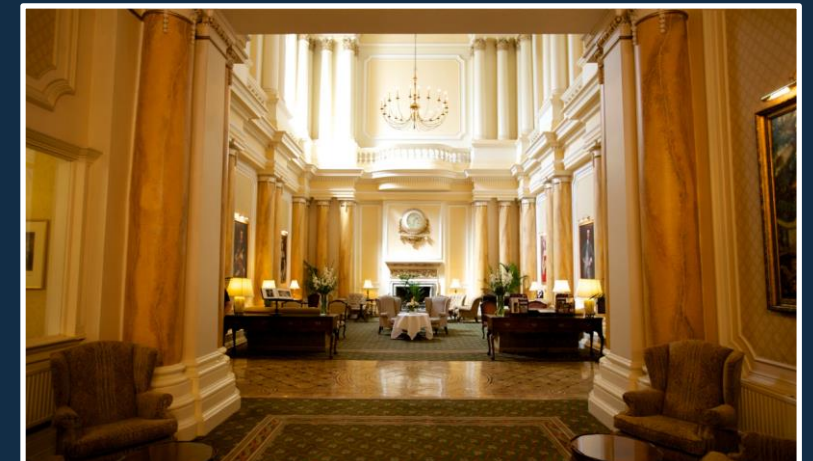

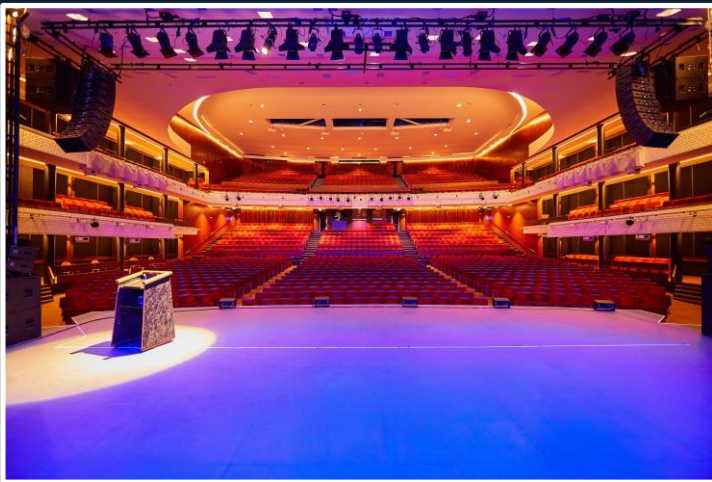
